This BLS entry-level course is for the EMT Basic. You will learn uniform assessment, management and stabilizing skills for injured or ill patients by using basic medical and trauma life support skills. Emphasis is placed on recognizing critical situations, airway management, medications, and other basic skills and interventions.

This course follows the most current national DOT EMT curriculum. After successful completion, students can take the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians' EMT Basic exam.
